TREE SPECIFICATIONS

EVERGREENS

- **American Arbor Vitae (White Cedar):** Moderate growth rate; tolerant to drought and poorly drained soils; grows best in moist, well-drained soils; moderately tolerant to shade; mature height, 20+ ft.
- **Norway Spruce:** Fastest growing of the spruce; moderately tolerant of drought; grows best in moist, well-drained soils; tolerant to shade; mature height, 50+ ft.
- **Black Hill Spruce:** Moderate to fast growth rate; moderately tolerant of drought; grows best in moist, well-drained soils; tolerant to shade; mature height, 30+ ft.
- **White Spruce:** Same as Black Hill Spruce but tolerates wetter soils and grows to 30+ ft.
- **Eastern Red Cedar:** Slow to moderate growth rate; tolerant to drought; grows best in moist, well drained soils; moderately tolerant to shade; mature height, 20+ ft.
- **White Pine:** Fast growing, tallest conifer species in MN. Pyramid shaped when young, broadening with age. Prefers sandy or silt loam soils, but will tolerate a wide range. Mature height 40+ ft.

TALL TREES

- **Red Maple:** Moderately rapid growth rate; prefers moist, well-drained soils but will tolerate poorly drained soils; full sun or partial shade; mature height 40-60 ft.
- **White Oak:** Moderate growth rate; prefers moist, well-drained soils but will tolerate heavy soils; intolerant to shade; mature height, 50+ ft.
- **Red Oak:** Moderately rapid growth rate; prefers moist, well-drained soils; moderately tolerant to shade; mature height, 50+ ft.

SMALL TREE/TALL SHRUB

- **Midwest Crabapple:** Rapid growth rate; prefers moist well drained soils but is adapted to a variety of soils; bears fruit every year, fruit persists into winter provide food for wildlife; mature height 15+ ft.
- **Villosa Lilac (non- suckering):** Moderate growth rate; prefers moist, well-drained soils; full sun; mature height 10-15 ft.; pinkish flowers.

SHRUBS

- **American Cranberrybush:** Moderately rapid growth rate; prefers moist, well drained soils but adapted to a variety of soils; partial shade to full sun; red fruit Aug. - Dec.; leaves turn red in the fall; mature height 8-12 ft.
 - **Black Chokeberry:** Moderately rapid growth rate; prefers moist well drained soils but adapted to a variety of soils; partial shade to full sun; white flowers; edible black fruit Oct.- Dec.; leaves turn maroon red in the fall; mature height 6-8 ft.
 - **Redosier Dogwood:** Fast growth rate, prefers wetter soils; full sun to partial shade; small white flowers; red stems; leaves turn red to purple in the fall; mature height, 8-10 ft
