#### **Natural Resource Conservation Service Report**

Nathan Bird, District Conservationist, United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) - Natural Resource Conservation Service (NRCS), informed the supervisors that the warmer weather has been helpful in being able to get in the field to look at projects with Jarod Matzke, Soil Conservation Technician. Bird noted that there are 6 EQIP applications approved for funding, one being complete, and the other five being a couple weeks from wrap-up. Bird added that funds from the Conservation Stewardship Program (CSP) will be carrying over, and after the April 7<sup>th</sup> CRP general signup closed there were no accepted applications. Bird told the Supervisors about the 4/11-4/14 NRCS meeting in Nisswa, MN that he and Jarod Matzke attended, and concluded by informing the Supervisors that Jessica Beske, District Conservationist in the Austin Field Office, accepted the NRCS Team Lead position in Mankato.

# Approval of the Treasurer's Financial Statements, Payment of New Bills

Glenn Hahn, Treasurer, presented the March 2023 Financial Report, including the Balance Sheet, Revenues of \$47,431.88, Expenditures of \$50,879.21, the General Ledger and Aging Summary, with payables total of \$4,826.33. # **Remote Computer and Server Management**

Adam King, District Manager, informed the supervisors that the IT firm supporting our office, TechRight Services Inc., has notified us of an increasing cost to the remote server management. King explained that in the past, TechRight Services Inc. has absorbed the cost, however, it is now a cost they must pass along to their customers. King presented the cost of remote computer/server management, which he noted would be increasing from \$3.50 per station (\$31.50 per month) to \$3.80 per station (\$34.20 per month). A motion was made to approve the price increase from TechRight Services Inc. for remote computer and server management.

#### WAGZ Cost-Share Contract 2023-WAGZ-DC-05 (Humphrey) Encumbrance

Cari Humphrey of Kasson, MN has requested cost-share assistance from the Dodge Soil and Water Conservation District for the installation of a 412-Grassed Waterway to be installed in Section 1 of Canisteo Township. The estimated cost for the practice is \$11,138.00, and Humphrey is requesting to encumber 27% using WAGZ Watershed Based Implementation Funding, not to exceed \$3,052.20. A motion was made to approve the encumbrance of cost-share contract 2023-WAGZ-DC-05 for Cari Humphrey, to install a 412-Grassed Waterway at 27% of the total cost of the project, not to exceed \$3,052.20 from the WAGZ Watershed Based Implementation Funding.

#### WAGZ Cost-Share Contract 2023-WAGZ-DC-02 (Edgar) Encumbrance

Dennis Edgar of Kasson, MN has requested cost-share assistance from the Dodge Soil and Water Conservation District for the installation of a 412-Grassed Waterway to be installed in Section 16/17 of Canisteo Township. The estimated cost for the practice is \$27,610.00, and he is requesting to encumber 17% using WAGZ Watershed Based Implementation Funding, not to exceed \$4,671.00. A motion was made to approve the encumbrance of cost-share contract 2023-WAGZ-DC-02 for Dennis Edgar to install a 412-Grassed Waterway at 17% of the total cost of the project, not to exceed \$4,671.00 from WAGZ Watershed Based Implementation Funding.

# **Correspondence & Staff Report**

Adam King, District Manager, informed the supervisors that the MASWCD Call for Resolutions is active and any new resolutions the supervisors would like considered should be proposed at the May board meeting, so they are on schedule for the July 21, 2023 due date. King added that he has been working on contacting landowners to gauge interest on cover crops to be installed and thinks there could be about 1,100 acres signed up initially. King relayed that Jessica Klingfus, District Technician, is working on adding projects to the list and that she will be having more encumbrances at the next meeting. Samantha Rojo, Administrative Professional, has been working on Envirothon planning and quarterly payroll tasks.

King also presented a vehicle repair quote for an O2 sensor replacement to the supervisors; the district's Ford Focus was the vehicle in question, and the supervisors agreed that staff should move forward with the appointment to have it repaired.
